Course Change Policy

Should a student need to either change courses or adjust the level at which the student is taking the course, the following guidelines will be observed:

1. Students may switch from one course to an unrelated course within the first twenty school days of the semester. Students who switch classes will be responsible for all the work missed in the new course and will be expected to write the exam for the whole course.
2. If a switch to a different level within the same course (i.e. university prep to college prep) cannot be made within the students present schedule such a change must be made within the first twenty days of the semester.
3. Students may switch to a different level within the same course until one week after midterm marks are sent home as long as the switch can be made within the present schedule of the student. A ten percent adjustment will be made as the differential between levels of difficulty.
4. A ten percent adjustment will be made as the differential between levels of difficulty when a level adjustment is made.
5. For all class switched or level adjustments, please see Ms. Dibbits in the Guidance Office. All changes require the permission of your parent or guardian.
